

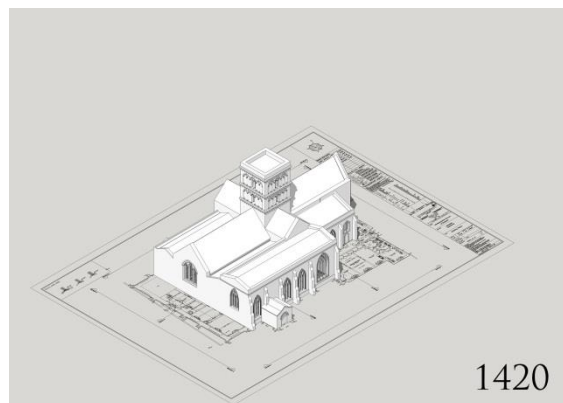
Summer student placement
