This event is open to all though families are particularly welcome. It will be the responsibility of participants to make arrangements to return to their cars and to be responsible for their children on the walk.

This is a really lovely thing to do. It is contemplative, has lovely scenery, historic, an opportunity for fellowship and very much within the Christian tradition both locally and worldwide. We are aiming to return in time to join the main service in the Cathedral at about 11:00.

## **Leicester Cathedral Revealed**

### **Leicester Cathedral Revealed – what next?**

On May 13<sup>th</sup> we were able to announce success in our bid to The National Lottery Heritage Fund for £3m towards the £11.3m needed for LCR. So what happens next?

### **Moving into Delivery stage**

Once funding is agreed there is a process called Permission to Start, which is now well under way – with forms already submitted to the local Heritage Fund office. Once that has been granted we can start spending this money, alongside our other project funds. Given that our Development phase runs out by the end of June, and its budget with it, it is important we can keep momentum going on all fronts as we prepare for action on the ground.

## **Closing the fundraising gap**

Our press release also made it clear we are still seeking a further £3m to be able to do all we intend. A lot of work is going on behind the scenes to close that gap – certainly enough to make the Heritage Fund people content that we can move forwards as we plan. But we are far from complacent!

## **Finalising the detail**

Our architects will be working closely over the summer with us, local planners and the national CFCE to finalise how we comply with planning conditions from those two bodies. After that it's a matter of what's called 'technical design' – turning our approved plans into something we can put out for tender to be actually built.

## **And it's Goodbye from me...**

As we move from Development into Delivery stage, I will be disembarking this ship, and making way for someone else to help steer it home into port. I'm certainly not leaving town, and will be staying around in an advisory capacity until my successor is properly in place - but retirement has arrived, and my last Sunday as a member of cathedral clergy will be June 23rd. If you can be there, it will be good to see you!
